2	Using the MF/HF and VHF marine radio demonstrate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How to log in with a marine rescue group • Call; • Response; • Changing channels; and • Signing off. 					
3	Using either marine radio demonstrate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A mayday call and message. 					
4	Using either marine radio demonstrate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Simulate (do not press button) a DSC distress alert. 					
5	Using the VHF marine radio demonstrate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Set a channel for dual watch.
