certificate, forklift, deck machinery etc, depending on the area of employment.

Four Semesters plus paid work experience in semester breaks and a possible Graduate position

Applicants should be:

- Commencing year 2 of their degree course at AMC in 2009

- Contact details of at least one other referee who can attest to the applicant's participation in AMC/UTAS or community activities.

The student must provide details that demonstrate excellence in undergraduate study and shows leadership potential.
