Task: Marine radio telephony operations – candidates are required to demonstrate a practical ability to operate a marine radio with DSC capabilities.

Conditions: Duration at the invigilator's discretion; no assistance should be given to the candidate.

1.	Using the MF/HF <u>and</u> VHF marine radio demonstrate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Turn on the transceiver. Adjust for volume. Tune receiver (VHF – n/a). Set channel for initial call. Reduce background noise. 					
2.	Using the MF/HF and VHF marine radio demonstrate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> How to log in with a marine rescue group. Call. Response. Changing channels. Signing off. 					
3.	Using either marine radio demonstrate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A mayday call and message. 					
4.	Using either marine radio demonstrate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Simulate (do not press button) a DSC distress alert. 					
5.	Using the VHF marine radio demonstrate: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Set a channel for dual watch.
